Mads Jakob Pagsberg (1970) has a master's degree. mag. in 1998 from the Department of Musicology with Film and TV as a minor. He has experience as a lecturer at the Department of Musicology at the University of Copenhagen (conductor, rotation / music management and event), high schools, day colleges, youth psychiatric department and private solo teaching. In addition to this, he has a work as a performing musician (bassist), choir conductor, composer and arranger, and has, among other things, arranged music for Danmarks Radios Bigband, Danmarks Radios Underholdningsorkester and NRK's Underholdningsorkester. Mads Pagsberg has trained hundreds of high school teachers and primary school teachers about music pedagogy. Has himself developed music pedagogical methods and published several books on this.

Mads Jakob Pagsberg (1970) has a master's degree from 1998 at the Department of Musicology. Mads Pagsberg has trained hundreds of high school teachers and primary school teachers in music pedagogy. It is the University's Academic Board on Education Strategy (KUUR), who will decide the winner of the Teacher of the Year Award on the basis of the nominations. KUUR will decide who is the Teacher of the Year during June.

When the KUUR has decided on the award winner, the winner will be contacted directly. All of you who have been nominated will also be informed about the winner of the award.
